## ANNOUNCING THE SECOND CALL FOR PROPOSALS – GREEN INNOVATION COMPETITIONS

Karatina University has branded itself as a 'The Green Entrepreneurial University'. The purpose is to achieve a green lifestyle among staff and students and change the mind-set of the university community towards embracing entrepreneurship in their day to day activities. To achieve this dream of transforming the University, deliberate efforts have been made to entrench a green entrepreneurial culture in the University's lifestyle. This includes promoting entrepreneurial innovations that build on sustainable living practices which are environmental friendly. In this regard, Karatina University is announcing the second **Green Innovation Competition** for students. The objective is to create awareness regarding the Green University Initiative, inculcate innovativeness in our academic endeavours, instil a green culture in our operations and turn every climate action into a business opportunity.

Students are therefore invited to submit competitive Green Innovation proposals for the second Green Innovations Competition. Applicants, who must be bonafide students of Karatina University, can apply either as individuals or as teams. The proposal should be based on an original idea focusing on solving climate change challenges in the community in an enterprise manner, using green approaches to provide green solutions. Dr Richard Munang's book entitled 'Making Africa Work through the Power of Innovative Volunteerism' could be an eye opener as applicants decide on areas of engagement to make climate action a business action.

The innovative and original designs will be evaluated by a Committee using the appended criteria. Shortlisted participants will be given an opportunity to present their project online before the committee. Participants in each presented project will be issued with certificates of participation. Besides, winners will be awarded as follows:

a. Position One (1) Ksh. 6000.00
b. Position Two (2) Ksh. 4000.00
c. Position Three (3) Ksh. 3000.00
d. Position Four (4) Ksh. 2000.00

The winning entries will be assigned staff members to assist the students to develop the idea further. Mentors will also connect students with external mentors for further development
