## A. BACKGROUND

Karatina University is a Chartered public university in Kenya. Situated 15km North off Karatina town, the University aspires to be one of the leading institutions of higher learning in Kenya and beyond. We offer quality education that is in tandem with the needs and aspirations of the global village as captured in our Vision, Mission and Core Values. Karatina University locality is rich in Agricultural soils and endowed with tourist attractions within the vicinity of snow-capped Mount Kenya. The serene environment makes it an ideal place for learning. This institution started in 2007 as Mount Kenya Campus of Moi University. It had succeeded a Tea Training institute. In 2010 it became Karatina University College, a Constituent College of Moi University. Finally, in 2013, Karatina University was awarded a Charter.

## B. CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

Karatina University invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from interested Hospitals having all necessary registration and based in Kenya. The Hospital should meet the following minimum criteria:

1. The Primary Medical facility to offer service to staff & their dependants across the Country.
2. Service providers to provide services to dependents of staff shall be required to have branches in majority of the Counties in the Country, which must include the main cities; Nairobi, Mombasa, Kisumu, Nakuru and Eldoret as well as a facility in all County headquarters.

3. The facility must be capable of providing the following services:

- i. Outpatient services
  - a. General consultation services
- ii. Dental Services
- iii. Maternity Services, Family planning, and MCH
- iv. Surgical Services
- v. inpatient services
- vi. Diagnostic Laboratory services
- vii. Pharmaceutical services
- viii. Specialized consultancy engaged by the hospital
- ix. Ambulance services
- x. ophthalmology and optical services xi. diagnostic radiology services
- xi. Specialized treatment including rehabilitative, oncology and
- xii. Palliative care
- xiii. Psychiatry/ counselling services

NB: xii and xiii we may source for a separate facility offering these services.

4. Must be Social Health Authority (SHA) accredited.

5. It shall have all the registrations /licenses /approvals/ authorizations required by law in order to provide the services required by the University;

6. Shall have the skills, knowledge and experience required in order to provide the service as required;

7. All persons engaged to offer services whether employees, agents or consultants are qualified and registered to practice in their respective areas;

8. The facility has taken out the requisite professional indemnity policies as prescribed by the regulating professional body where the same are required to.

9. Shall have capacity to identify staff and their dependants through electronic means.

10. Shall allow the University to make payment only after receipt of intimation and the necessary medical details and after it has ascertained the eligibility of coverage and issued the Preauthorization.

Only firms pre-qualified under this procedure will be invited to submit their Technical and Financial proposals under the Request for Proposals (RFP).
