Please be advised that a wild animal was sighted within the Botanical Forest area last night. As a precautionary measure, we kindly request all staff and students to exercise caution and, where possible, avoid the Botanical Forest area for the time being, especially during the evening and night hours.

The Kenya Wildlife Service (KWS) has already been notified and is handling the matter. It is hoped that the "visitor" will soon be safely relocated back to its natural habitat.

There is no cause for alarm, but we encourage everyone to remain vigilant and cooperate with the temporary precautionary measures.
